Eligibility

Applicant must:

- Be a resident of Kaua`i.
- Be a member, or a child/grandchild of a member, or be eligible to become a member. (For eligibility requirements visit our website @ www.kgefcu.org. Verification of eligibility is required.)
- Be a graduating senior from any public/private high school/home school and be in good academic standing.
- Show proof of acceptance into any accredited college or university as a full-time student.

Judging Criteria

Financial Need

A Financial Aid Form or Parents 2010 Federal Tax Return must be submitted with this application to avoid disqualification.

Scholastic

Students must have maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average throughout their three years of high school and submit a current official transcript with this application.

Academic Achievements and Leadership

Honors, extra-curricular activities such as student government, sports, various committees, organizations, and school sanctioned clubs.

Community Service

Scouts, part-time employment, volunteer work, etc.

Two Letters of Recommendations

Letters from teachers, employers, clergy or any non-related individuals who can attest to the applicant's character and potential.

Essay or Personal Statement

Submit an essay or personal statement of at least 200 words on why you are applying for one of four Kaua`i Government Employees Federal Credit Union scholarships.
