

URGENT!

MEMBERS PLEASE BE AWARE OF A RECENT CELL PHONE PHISHING SCAM!!

Aloha Members, it has been brought to our attention that a telephone phishing scam is sweeping the island.

It generally comes across your cell phone display as a three or four digit phone number. Not a complete 10 digit phone number. An automated voice then states something similar to the following” “This is First Hawaiian (or some other generic/large Financial institution) we are cancelling your debit card or credit card or we need to verify information on your debit card. Please press 1 to enter your information.

There are several variations of this phishing scheme but this is the most common.

DO NOT GIVE ANY INFORMATION OUT WHATSOEVER! HANG UP ON THE CALL!

Please call the CU if you feel you have been compromised by this phishing scheme. 808-245-2463

We have confirmed that our Members data **has not been** compromised and is secure. The Phishing Scheme attempts to extract the info from unsuspecting persons. Always be careful who you provide information too. If you did not initiate the call, do not provide any information.
